The meeting ID is 288 830 5105 and the access password is Shipmate. **EMPLOYMENT** Manpower and training support company Mabway has 100 vacancies for ex-military individuals to take part in military exercises as weapon carriers, role playing as insurgents, security forces or enemy forces. They must have had military weapons training, to at least the end of Phase One training, and be capable of passing a weapon handling test, before being considered for the role. The work will require a certain robust level of fitness and endurance. Pay is £12.30 hourly basic starting rate, a shift is normally 10 hours or on occasion 12 hours (£147.60). This is a Zero Hours contract.

There is also a position for someone with a stores-based backaround on a full-time contract, providing loaistic support before, during and after training events to ensure Mabway participants are appropriately equipped and sustained. The role will be based at Mabway's stores facility in Hayling Island, and the pay is £28,000pa. Essential requirements include: UK security vetting standard of CTC; previous experience in a logistic support role, ideally, but not necessarily in a military context; full UK driving license; be able to work on a routine basis from the Hayling (five days a week, inc weekends; live close enough to react to any alarm activation, within the hour, in the absence of the Base Stores Manager; be able to deploy for periods of up to 3 weeks.
