**SCHOOL FEES** The recent government decision implement VAT on school fees starting in January 2025 may create unexpected financial strain for some Naval families. The Naval Children's Charity (NCC), in partnership with Greenwich Hospital, has established a hardship fund to provide financial support to eligible families. To be eligible, at least one parent must still be serving, and the child/ children must be at a critical stage of education or have additional needs. Families receiving CEA will not be eligible. To confirm eligibility, you will find a short form here. Once that is completed, you can download the full application form, which must be submitted, along with the required supporting documents, by 13 December. For full details, please click here.

**PENSIONS** Households receiving certain benefits, including Pension Credit, may be eligible for government financial support during extremely cold spells between 1 November and the end of March 2025. You can check eligibility at https:// tinyurl.com/nmz4hpnv

**HEARING LOSS** A High Court decision in the summer opened the way for more Armed Forces veterans who suffered hearing loss as a result of their service. A campaign to widen eligibility was led by a commercial law firm, and several specialist firms dealing in military law are supporting cases. Compensation is paid under various existing schemes, including the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme.
